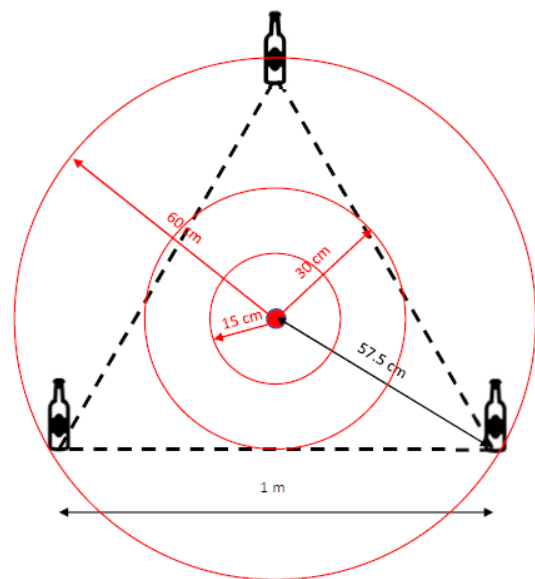
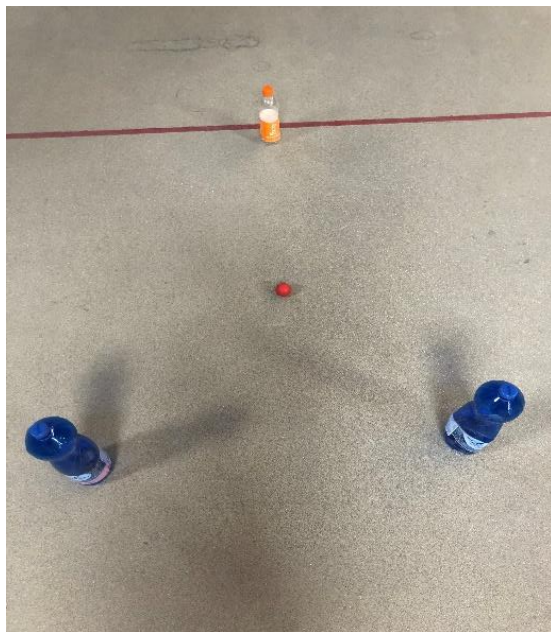


Special Olympics Challenge

Skill Bocce 1 – BOTTLES



Presentation of the skill

The goal of the skill is to put four bocce balls into the triangle formed by the three bottles (PET, empty, 0.5 l). The distance between the bottles is 1 m. The pallino ball is placed 11 m from the starting line, the bottles are placed around this and the triangle is drawn on the ground. The pallino ball is at the centre of the triangle. The distance from the ball to the bottle is approximately 57.5 cm.

Effect of the skill

This skill develops concentration and accuracy.

Guidelines for communication of the results

- The measurement is made from the side of the pallino to the closest extremity of the boccia, not from the centres of the two spheres
- 0 points: if the boccia is outside the triangle or if the bottle falls
- 1 point: if the boccia is between 60 cm and 30 cm of the ball and the boccia is inside the triangle
- 2 points: if the boccia is from 30 cm to 15 cm and the boccia is inside the triangle
- 3 points: if the boccia is from 15 cm to 0 cm and the boccia is inside the triangle
- Make two tries, with a pause of a few minutes between them

- The result of the best try counts double. The final result is the sum of the results of the two tries.

Example:

- Try 1: 5 points
- Try 2: 8 points.
- Result: $5+(8 \times 2) = 21$ points

Rules of the skill

- Each play is made with 4 bocce of the same diameter and weight.
- If the pallino ball moves, it is placed back in the centre after each shot.
- Each boccia is measured individually and then removed from the playing field.
