Information about the tournament	<p>Gothia Cup is the biggest youth football tournament in the world. Gothia Special Olympics Trophy is included in Gothia Cup.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The tournament welcomes both male teams and female teams.- The Gothia Special Olympics Trophy can receive 15 Scandinavian teams and 15 international teams, i.e. a total of 30 teams.- Teams that register and pay the registration deposit (100 Euro) will have priority.

<p>Additional Information</p>	<p>Insurance: → Covered by participants</p> <p>Costs: → All onsite costs as listed below will be covered by SO Sweden, but a registration deposit fee of 100 Euro per team will have to be paid upon registration. → The deposit fee will be refunded after the tournament on condition that the team has participated → Covered Costs: - Accommodation in school classroom - Three meals per day (breakfast, lunch, dinner) starting with Sunday dinner and last meal served on Thursday lunch - Local public Transportation - Transfer to and from airport if needed - Ticket to the Opening Ceremony → Travel costs to Sweden, additional nights or meals must be covered by participants</p> <p>Support SOSWI: → Official equipment for Opening Ceremony → Basic equipment (e.g. T-shirt or Poloshirt) → Team Dress for the Games → Administrative support</p>
