Unified (111m, 222m, 333m, 20 rounds relay, 20 rounds Unified relay) - Category 3 (222m, 333m, 500m, 20 rounds relay) <p>→ Athletes can only compete in 1 category, but there in each distance → Relays consists of 4 persons, Unified ratio 2/2</p>
